Main Functions - Freelance NIFSA Forest School Trainer

- 1. To run forest school sessions in schools for teachers undertaking their Forest School Level 3 qualification.
- 2. To liaise with the NIFSA Forest School Development Manager in relation to the Forest School sessions, dates unavailable, issues that arise etc.
- 3. To complete a presentation, editing a template, following sessions in schools and send them to the NIFSA Forest School Development Manager promptly.
- 4. To take photos, after checking permissions with teachers, for use in presentation and to share with NIFSA Forest School Development Manager for socials.
- 5. To attend meetings/training as appropriate and keep up to date with current developments and practice.
- 6. To be able to complete dates committed to running and give advance notice when not available (some exceptions permitted).
- 7. To carry out all responsibilities and activities within an equal opportunities framework.
- 8. To work within agreed policies and practices, including behaviour management, child protection, equal opportunities and Health & Safety.
