

## Forest school lesson plan – collect sticks and make a game

Class – P4 (survival skills after school club)

### Beforehand

- Ensure children know the rules – 1 whistle stop, 2 whistles come to me.
- Encourage appropriate clothing and footwear
- Risk assessment of site before children go out
- Remind children of behaviour expectations
- Keep in touch with parents so they know what is happening

**Introduction** – Ask children to get into groups.

- Discuss straight, forked and y sticks – show an example of each
- Walk around grounds and try to find sticks.
- Have a resource of stick pile

Learning Objective	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Children will work together</li><li>• Children will use their imagination</li><li>• Children will discuss their finding with the group</li></ul>
Lesson	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Give children a challenge – Can they collect 20 sticks and create a game?</li><li>• Ask children for their evaluation – did they enjoy the activity?</li><li>• Leave no trace</li><li>• Return to school</li></ul>
Resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Whistle</li><li>• kit bag</li><li>• boundary markers</li><li>• first aid kit</li><li>• wipes &amp; hand gel</li><li>• Bag for rubbish</li><li>• Sticks</li><li>• Camera</li></ul>
Evaluation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Children stood beside the happy face or sad face depending on whether they enjoyed the activity. Ask for feedback</li></ul>
